

BINGEN CITY COUNCIL MINUTES
Special Meeting

June 23, 2010

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Betty Barnes at 6:30 p.m. Council members present: Clinton Bryan, Laura Mann, Catherine Kiewit, Guillermo Fisch. Council members absent: Sandi Dickey. City Administrator Jan Brending was present. Audience: Jesse Burkhardt.

Skatepark Fundraising

Council members and staff discussed the fundraising event for the skatepark at First Friday in Hood River on July 2. Laura Mann agreed to represent the city at the booth. Betty Barnes said that Maria Perez and her children will also be in attendance.

The council agreed to have on-hand at the event a large size poster, one page flyer to hand out to citizens and a sign-up sheet for future information.

Jan Brending said she will contact Elaine Bakke at The Enterprise to see if there is a possibility that ad space could be donated so the city can run an ad about fundraising for the skatepark.

There was a consensus of the council to have a booth/table at Huckleberry Festival to bring more awareness to the skatepark. Jan Brending noted the skatepark will be under construction at that time. She said she will contact Bill Hunsaker with the White Salmon Fire Department to see if they would be interested in donating any of their proceeds from the Huckleberry Pancake Breakfast to the skatepark.

Clinton Bryan suggested holding a 3-on-3 basketball tournament at the Huckleberry Festival to help raise money.

Information about the skatepark and the status of the fundraising will be posted at city hall.
