

RESOLUTION 2012-008

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF BINGEN, WASHINGTON
REGARDING PROPERTY TAX INCREASE**

WHEREAS, the City Council of Bingen, Washington has properly given notice to the public hearing held on November 5th, 2012, to consider the City's current expenses budget for the 2013 calendar year, pursuant to RCW 84.55.120; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of Bingen after hearing and after duly considering all relevant evidence and testimony presented, has determined that the best interests of the City of Bingen requires a regular levy in the amount of \$190,989.82 which includes an increase in property tax revenue from the previous year, in addition to the increase resulting from the addition of new construction or improvements to property, and any increase in the value of state assessed property, in order to discharge the expected expenses and obligations of the City of Bingen;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Bingen, that an increase in the regular property tax levy, in addition to any amount resulting from the addition of new construction and improvements to property and any increase in the value of state-assessed property, is hereby authorized for the 2013 levy in the amount of \$1,890.99 which is a percentage increase of 1% from the previous year. This increase is exclusive of additional revenue resulting from the addition of new construction and improvements to property and any increase in the value of state assessed property, and any additional amounts resulting from any annexations that have occurred and refunds made.

ADOPTED by the City Council of the City of Bingen, Washington and approved by its Mayor, at a regularly scheduled open public meeting thereof this 5th day of November, 2012.





RESOLUTION NO. 2012-007

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF BINGEN
WAIVING COMPETITIVE BID REQUIREMENTS TO PURCHASE
ALAN BRADLEY EQUIPMENT PER RCW 39.04.280**

WHEREAS, the Revised Code of Washington (RCW) 39.04.280 allows the governing body of a municipality to waive competitive bidding requirements when purchases are clearly and legitimately limited to a single source of supply; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bingen needs to purchase Alan Bradley equipment for the installation of aerators at the Bingen Treatment Plant that can only be purchased through Consolidated Electrical Distributors, the sales company for Alan Bradley equipment in the City of Bingen jurisdiction;

RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:**


Per RCW 39.04.280 (1)(a), the City of Bingen waives competitive bidding requirements to purchase Alan Bradley equipment for the installation of aerators.
