

RESOLUTION 2012-009

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF BINGEN, WASHINGTON AUTHORIZING SURPLUS OF VEHICLES, EQUIPMENT AND MATERIALS NO LONGER USEABLE TO THE CITY

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Bingen has reviewed the following list of items

WHEREAS, the City of Bingen desires to surplus the items listed of value and surplus useable items; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bingen desires to designate any items not sold in surplus to have no value and to be donated to an appropriate agency or disposed of; and

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BINGEN, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The following items are to be surplused through a bidding process:

Treatment Plant

Section 2. The City of Bingen authorizes the City Administrator to donate all surplus equipment and materials (excluding vehicles) that are not purchased through the bidding process to an appropriate agency to be determined or to be disposed of in consultation with the Mayor.

Section 3. Funds received from the surplus sale shall be deposited into the following funds:

Fund received from the sale of surplus items from the Treatment Plant shall be deposited in 425 – Treatment Plant Replacement Fund.

Funds received from the sale of surplus items from the Fire Department shall be deposited in 152 – Fire Equipment Reserve Fund.

Funds received from the sale of surplus items from the Clerk/Finance Department shall be deposited in 301 – Building Construction Fund.

Funds received from sale of surplus items from the Public Works Department – General shall be divided evenly and deposited into 305 – Park Construction Fund, 153 – Street Equipment Fund, 422 – Water Equipment Fund, and 424 – Sewer Equipment Fund.

Funds received from sale of surplus items from the Public Works Department – Park shall be deposited into 305 – Park Construction Fund.

Funds received from sale of surplus items from the Public Works Department – Street shall be deposited into 153 – Street Equipment Fund.

Funds received from sale of surplus items from the Public Works Department – Water shall be deposited into 422 – Water Equipment Fund.
