**ORDINANCE NO. 2016-14-670**

**AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF BINGEN,  
Klickitat County, State of Washington for the Year 2017**

WHEREAS, the Mayor of the City of Bingen, completed and placed on file with the City Clerk a proposed budget and estimate of money required to meet the public expenses, bond retirement and interest, reserve funds and expenses of government of said city for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2017, and notice was published that the council of said city would meet on the 1<sup>st</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> days of November and 6<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2016, at the hour of 7:00 p.m at the council chambers in the City Hall of said city for the purpose of making and adopting a budget of said fiscal year and giving taxpayers within the limits of said city an opportunity to be heard upon said budget; and

WHEREAS, the said city council did meet at said time and place and did then consider the matter of said proposed budget; and

WHEREAS, the said proposed budget does not exceed the lawful limit of taxation allowed by law to be levied on the property within the City of Bingen for the purposes set forth in said budget, and the estimated expenditures set forth in said budget being all necessary to carry on the government of said city for said year and being sufficient to meet the various needs of said city during said period.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the City Council of the City of Bingen do ordain as follows:

**Section 1.** The budget for the City of Bingen, Washington for the year 2017 is hereby adopted in its final form and content, three (3) copies of which are on file in the Office of the Clerk.

**Section 2.** Estimated resources, including cash balances or working capital for each separate fund of the City of Bingen and aggregate totals (net of transactions between funds) for

all such funds combined, for the year 2017 are set forth in summary form below (rounded to the nearest dollar), and are hereby appropriated for expenditure during the year 2017 as set forth below:


