Article II. Sewers

Chapter 13.32

SEWER AND SEPTIC TANK WORKER LICENSE

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13.32.010 Required.

No person shall construct or attempt to construct a sewer connection within the city until he has first obtained a license as a sewer worker. No person shall engage in septic tank cleaning, construction or repair within the city until he has first obtained a license as a septic tank worker. (Ord. 118 §601, 1955).

13.32.020 Application.

Every person desiring to obtain a license as a sewer worker or septic tank worker in the city shall make application to the sewer superintendent for an examination as a sewer worker. (Ord. 118 §602, 1955).

13.32.030 Examination.

Superintendent shall promptly examine the applicant, touching his qualifications to construct sewer connections, testing his familiarity and experience in jointing sewer pipe and the specifications as set forth in this article. Septic tank workers will be examined on fundamentals of tank construction, connection and cleaning. (Ord. 118 §603, 1955).

13.32.040 Certification of qualifications.

If the applicant be found to possess sufficient qualification and experience and satisfy said superintendent, the superintendent shall certify in writing the fact of his approval to the city clerk and deliver said certificate to the applicant. (Ord. 118 §604, 1955).

13.32.050 Issuance-Fee-Term.

Upon the payment of ten dollars to the city clerk he shall issue a license authorizing the applicant to make sewer connections or do septic tank work within the city for the period of one year from the date of license. Said license shall state upon the face of same that it is revocable at the pleasure of the city council. (Ord. 118 §605, 1955).

13.32.060 Appeal.

In the event the sewer superintendent should refuse to grant to the applicant the certificate of approval, said applicant shall have the right to appeal to the council. (Ord. 118 §606, 1955).

13.32.070 Revocation-Authority.

The council shall have the right at any time to revoke any license granted under the provisions of this article and return the pro-rate unearned license fee. (Ord. 118 §701, 1955).

13.32.080 Revocation-Grounds.

In addition to other causes, the neglect, omission, failure or refusal of any sewer worker licensed under this article to comply with and observe the provisions of this article in the manner of construction or class of material used therein shall be deemed sufficient cause to justify the council in revoking the license of said sewer worker. (Ord. 118 §702, 1955).

13.32.090 License-Suspension-Effect.

No person whose license has been suspended shall perform any acts for which a license is required by this article until the matter of such suspension has been voted by the council. (Ord. 118 §703, 1955).

13.32.100 Employees of licensee exempt.

The provisions of Sections 13.32.010 through 13.32.060 shall not apply to any person or is a bona fide employee of any person or firm in the city duly licensed as a sewer worker; provided, however, that every person engaged in laying pipe and making joints shall be required to obtain a license as provided in Sections 13.32.010 through 13.32.060. (Ord. 118 §704, 1955).
