Description of Proposal: The project encompasses Schedule A: Wastewater Treatment Facility Improvements; which provide for existing aerobic digester modifications including waste removal and cleaning, furnishing, and installing three new blowers, a new fine bubble diffuser aeration system, and installation of one Owner-supplied submersible mixer. The project also includes modifications to an existing oxidation ditch including furnishing and installing new aspirating mixers, instrumentation, and piping; and SEPA Environmental checklist (WAC 197-11-960) July 2016 Page 3 of 19 construction of a new concrete bio selector structure and mixer platform. The project also includes concrete crack and surface repairs to a second oxidation ditch structure as well as all associated electrical work and site restoration. The entire wastewater treatment facility covers an area approximately 11,500 square yards in area.

The project also encompasses Schedule B: Sewer Improvements; which includes the replacement of approximately 1,750 linear feet of existing 10-inch sanitary sewer main with new 18-inch sanitary sewer main, including side sewers; trenchless CIPP (cured-in-place pipe) replacement of approximately 870 linear feet of existing 8-inch and 10-inch sanitary sewer main; manhole rehabilitation and minor repair of approximately 22 existing manholes; and associated restoration work.

Location of Proposal: The Schedule A improvements will be located at the City's existing Wastewater Treatment Facility located at 208 East Marina Way. The Schedule B Collection System Improvements will occur mainly within Depot St. and various spot locations throughout the City
