DISORDERLY CONDUCT

9.30.010 Disorderly persons defined and enumerated.

Without limitation to the provisions of RCW 9A.84.030, the following persons are declared to be disorderly persons:

- A. Any person fighting, pushing, shoving, slapping or hitting another, or any person encouraging another to fight, push, shove, slap or hit anyone in any public place in the city of Bingen;
- B. Any person who, by any noise, including yelling, shouting, hooting, whistling or singing on or near city streets, particularly between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m., or at any other time and place unreasonably disturbs or interferes with the peace, comfort and repose of another, or by riotous or tumultuous conduct disturbs the quiet and peace of the city or of any meeting or assemblage therein;
- C. Any person who, in a manner or under circumstances likely to cause an assault, uses vulgar, profane, or induced language or gestures;
- D. Any person, who without lawful authority intentionally obstructs vehicular traffic;
- E. Any person who, without proper authorization, willfully removes, defaces, injures, or destroys any street sign or sign erected or placed in or adjacent to any street, which sign indicates the name of the street or serves as a traffic control device;
- F. Any person who transmits a fire alarm when that person knows that there is no fire or summons police or ambulance on the pretext that an emergency exists if that person knows that there is no such emergency;
- G. Any person who urinates or defecates in any public place other than a wash room or toilet; or
- H. Any person who suffers or permits in a public building or public place owned by that or under that person's control fighting, pushing, shoving, slapping or hitting of another, or the presence of any person who encourages another to fight, push, shove, slap or hit anyone in any public place in the city of Bingen.

- I. Any person who suffers or permits in a public building or public place owned by that or under that person's control any noise, including yelling, shouting, hooting, whistling or singing on or near city streets, particularly between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m., or at any other time and place which unreasonably disturbs or interferes with the peace, comfort and repose of another, or riotous or tumultuous conduct which disturbs the quiet and peace of the city, or of any meeting or assemblage therein.

9.30.020 Violation – Penalty.

It is illegal to be a disorderly person in the city of Bingen. Every person violating any provision of this chapter shall be guilty of the crime of disorderly conduct, which crime is a misdemeanor with a maximum penalty of 90 days in jail and a \$1,000 fine. (Ord. 543, 2008)
