13.06.010 Connections required—Expense.

All applications that are requesting water/sewer services from the city of Bingen shall, at their exclusive expense, are required to extend and bear the cost thereof for all materials and installation expenses of any water and sewer lines from their property line to the connection point of the existing city line. (Ord. 300 (part), 1981).

13.06.020 Approval and inspection required.

All installation of water and sewer lines, including street repairs as required, must be approved and inspected by the city council of the city prior to such installation. (Ord. 300 (part), 1981).

13.06.030 City Ownership.

Subsequent to the installation of said water/sewer line by any property owner to the existing city line at its connection point, the City of Bingen shall become the owner of all right, title and interest therein said lines up to the applicant's property line, and the city shall bear the maintenance expenses from said point of connection to the junction of the applicant's property line. (Ord. 300 (part), 1981).

13.06.040 Restoration of streets.

In the event the water or sewer line installation shall cross a city street, then in such event the applicant or property owner shall restore the street to its status quo condition as existing before such installation. (Ord. 300 (part), 1981).

13.06.050 City's right of lien.

Nothing in this chapter shall derogate against any of the provisions set forth in Chapter 13.04 et seq. or Chapter 13.08 et seq., and in the event that the applicant shall fail to pay for such materials, installation and costs attendant hereto, the City of Bingen shall reserve the right to file

a lien therefor against said property owner as provided under the laws of the state of Washington.
