

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF BINGEN
REGARDING ESTABLISHMENT OF EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES DISTRICT**

WHEREAS, the Skyline Hospital and Klickitat Valley Health Services have requested the Klickitat County Board of Commissioners to consider the formation of a county wide emergency medical services district; and

WHEREAS, the residents of the City of Bingen are currently provided emergency medical services by Skyline Hospital; and


WHEREAS, the proposed boundary for the proposed county emergency medical services district includes the City of Bingen; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bingen finds that the formation of a county-wide emergency medical services district and the inclusion of the City within the district boundaries will benefit the citizens of the City of Bingen;

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BINGEN, WASHINGTON DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

The City of Bingen requests Klickitat County to include the City of Bingen within the boundaries of the proposed county wide emergency medical services district, the formation of which will be placed on a future election ballot.
