

BINGEN CITY COUNCIL MINUTES

DRAFT – December 21, 2020

Special Meeting Via Teleconference

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Betty J Barnes at 7:10 pm. Council members present: Phil Jones, Ryan O’Connor, Catherine Kiewit, Joseph O’Sullivan, Isolde Schroder. Staff present: City Clerk Cheyenne Pantoja Wright, City Attorney Christopher R Lanz, Public Works Superintendent David Spratt. Audience Present: Rich Murray, Radcomp Technologies.

2021 MSP Agreement - Radcomp

Rich Murray with Radcomp explained the options for renewing the MSP agreement. He said the biggest decision to be made was whether the City wanted Radcomp to provide SCADA monitoring. Murray explained SCADA monitoring in further detail.

Council and staff discussed the benefits of having the SCADA system monitored.

There was a consensus to budget for the Premium MSP option and look into receiving a discounted rate.

Public Hearing – 2021 Draft Budget (Continued)

Mayor Barnes opened the continued public hearing on the 2021 draft budget.

Clerk Pantoja Wright explained notable changes with the 2021 draft budget including an increase in cost for services received from BIAS Software and Radcomp Technologies, a change in payroll splits for Public Works employees, an increase in medical insurance rates, unused swimming pool dollars, and playground equipment purchases put on hold due to the pandemic.

Mayor Barnes closed the public hearing.

The council adjourned at 7:58 pm.
