Section 2. The City of Bingen authorizes the City Administrator to donate all surplused equipment and materials (excluding vehicles) that are not purchased through the

bidding process to an appropriate agency to be determined or to be disposed of in consultation with the Mayor.

Section 3. Funds received from the surplus sale shall be deposited into the following funds:

Funds received from the sale of surplus items from the Treatment Plant shall be deposited in 425 – Treatment Plant Improvement Fund.

Funds received from the sale of surplus items from the Fire Department shall be deposited in 152 – Fire Equipment Fund.

Funds received from the sale of surplus items from the Clerk/Finance Department shall be deposited in 150 – Equipment Fund.

Funds received from the sale of surplus items from the General Fund shall be deposited in 150 – Equipment Fund.
