ORDINANCE NO. 2012-05-602

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING BINGEN MUNICIPAL CODE 10.12, SPEED LIMITS

WHEREAS, the Washington Department of Transportation has established speed limits on State Route 14 and State Route 141 within the city limits of the City of Bingen; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that amendments are necessary to Bingen Municipal Code 10.12, Speed Limits; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Bingen do ordain as follows:

**Section 1.** Bingen Municipal Code 10.12, Speed Limits incorporated here by reference and by such incorporation set forth at full length, is hereby repealed.

**Section 2.** Bingen Municipal Code 10.12, Speed Limits is amended to read as follows:

10.12.010 Speed limits designated.

There is established the following speed limits which shall be applicable in the areas within the city which shall be applicable in the areas within the city as follows:

- A. From Willow Street to Cedar Street on State Route 14, the speed limit shall be designated as twenty-five miles per hour.
- B. From Cedar Street to the east city limits within the city limits on State Route 14, the speed limit shall be designated as thirty-five miles per hour.
- C. From the west city limits to ~~Willow Street~~ **Mile Post 65.85** on State Route 14, the speed limit shall be designated as forty miles per hour.
- D. **From Mile Post 65.85 to Willow Street on State Route 14, the speed limit shall be designated as thirty miles per hour.**

**DE.** From the intersection of State Route 14 with State Route 141 (also known as the intersection of West Steuben Street with Oak Street) to the intersection of ~~Ash~~ Lincoln Street and State Route 141, the speed limit shall be designated as twenty-five miles per hour.

**EF.** From the intersection of ~~Ash~~ Lincoln Street with State Route 141 on State Route 141, to the north city limits, the speed limit shall be designated as thirty-five miles per hour.

**G.** All other streets of the city, the speed limit shall be designated as twenty-five miles per hour.

**Section 3.** This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its publication according to law.


